

Reading

We would like you to try and listen to your child read every night and comment in their reading record.

Please send in their reading record on a Friday morning. If your child has read 5 times through the week, they will receive a stamp/signature in their reading record.. After 6 stamps your child will receive a bronze reading certificate. This is then followed by a silver reading certificate and a gold certificate along with a book to keep.

Children will receive a new Read, Write Inc book every Wednesday. In addition to this, extra books are available in our reading sheds in the school yard. Please help yourself and return when you have finished.

We also have a class story box that is sent home with a child on a Friday. This includes a teddy, hot chocolate and blanket to enjoy with your child as you read the story together.



Things you will need every day:

- Coat (We may still go outside for playtime in the rain!)
- Bookbag (No backpacks please as these do not fit on pegs)
- Water bottle with your name on.
- *Please do NOT bring pencil cases or toys into school.*
